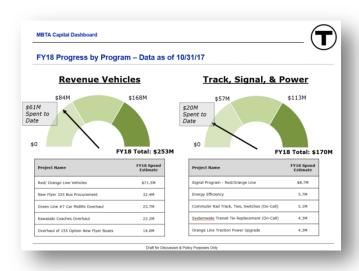

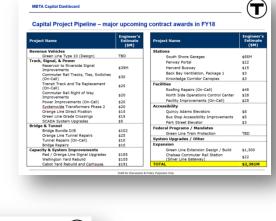

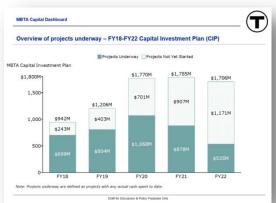
Capital Dashboard Overview

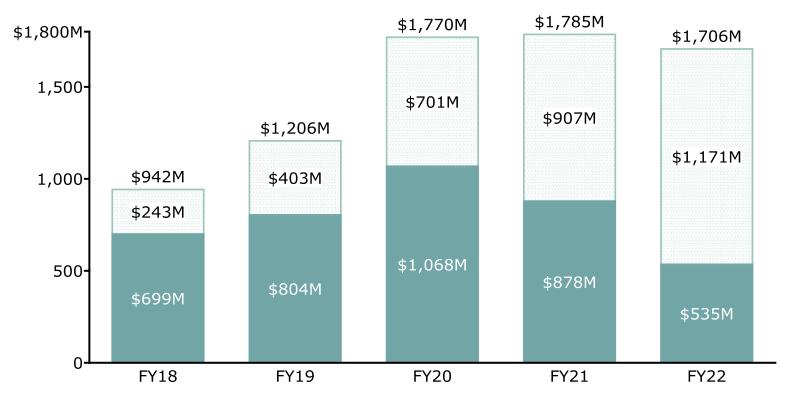

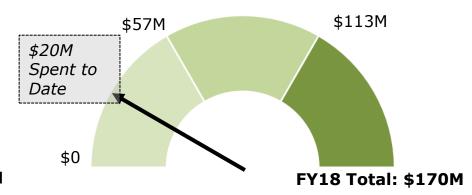
