Scope

• Full Station Replacement

Progress

Demolition of overhead canopy, removal of fare collection machines, escalator complete. Drainage improvements, foundation for new head house underway.

Busing to NQ and Quincy Center successful, public outreach & coordination with City of Quincy and elected officials ongoing.

Schedule

- Station Closed Jan 8, 2018
- Station Re-opens Summer 2019

Construction Cost

• \$33M

Scope

Demolition of the existing shafts and head houses, structural modifications, installation of new larger elevator facilities.



- Other management initiatives that find cost savings, operational efficiencies, and result in delivering a better service for customers



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


Overview of projects underway – FY18-FY22 Capital Investment Plan (CIP)




Overview of projects underway – FY18-FY22 Capital Investment Plan (CIP) SGR Projects Only




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
